



2018-2019 Step 1 Allstars Tryout Information

It is that time of year again – tryout time for the Step 1 Allstars’ 2018-2019 competitive season! As one of the oldest cheerleading and tumbling training facilities in Ohio, Step 1 Allstars is unparalleled, with a world-class staff, engaging classes and a highly successful competitive team program. Having spent the past 16 years developing athletes both physically and mentally, we have the program, knowledge and expertise that combine to set us apart from other organizations. We understand that in addition to providing training in high level skills and proper skill progression, there must also be a focus on participants learning important life skills such as teamwork, leadership, and sportsmanship. The Step 1 Allstars staff works hand in hand with our athletes and parents in all these areas to ensure we collectively achieve our goal of successful athletes and competitive teams. The best part is, Step 1 Allstars has a place for everyone to be successful! It doesn’t matter the level of experience, we have teams for all ages and skill levels.

The Step 1 Allstars tryout process is unique, developed after our years of experience, starting with attending one of the mandatory Athlete Evaluation Days and followed by Callbacks. Although we call it a tryout, it starts out with Athlete Evaluations, which simply put is an evaluation of existing skills and athlete potential with the focus on the individual athlete. In a motivating and relaxed environment, each athlete is encouraged to demonstrate her or his skills. Callbacks then allows athletes numerous opportunities to further demonstrate their skills, skills in progress, and work ethic, both individually and with others. Throughout this entire tryout process, the Step 1 Allstars staff will assess a combination of athlete’s tumbling, jumping, and stunting skills, as well as future potential. This is all done from the perspective of providing each athlete the greatest opportunity to excel and develop.

Once “Callbacks” are complete, we will form the official 2018-2019 Step 1 Allstars teams. The staff will spend many hours evaluating all the athletes, assessing numerous factors (age, skill level, etc.) to develop the teams that we believe will be the most competitive and successful in the upcoming season. We will use the USASF skill guidelines and competition score sheets to aid in this process to ensure each of our teams is as age and level appropriate as possible. Our ultimate goal is to find a good fit for all athletes, where they can showcase their skills and gain confidence throughout the season by participating on a successful team. This only happens through assembling the strongest combination of athletes for each team and this can only be done after evaluating all the athletes who have tried out.

– May 21, 2018
 Levels 1 & 2: 6:00-7:00 pm
 Levels 3 & 4: 7:15-8:15 pm
 Level 5: 8:30-9:30 pm

Athletes will come to these level specific times based on the level they wish to try out for. After Assessment Days are complete, coaches will invite each athlete to a specific level call back later in the week. **Athletes may be asked to come to multiple call backs at the coaches’ discretion. Please plan your week accordingly.**

 Thursday, May 24th: Level 5 Call Back (ALL AGES)

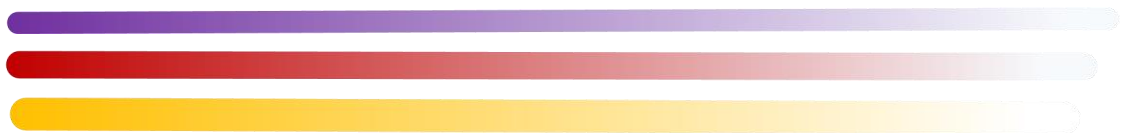

APPROXIMATE SEASON FEES

Although we can't be certain of exact fees until teams are formed, and expenses are factored in the below fees will help to prepare your finances for the season.

Step 1 Allstars uses all-inclusive monthly billing for almost all expenses. Instead of different fee amounts billed out each month, there will be one consistent fee that covers almost all fees. The goal of this switch is to make budgeting easier on the Step 1 Allstars parents.

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Monthly Fees

Tiny Team (6 and under) - \$60-\$125 per month (based on an annual fee broke down into 11 equal monthly payments: will depend on whether this team is competitive or a show team)

Mini Team (8 and under) - \$215-\$250 per month (based on an annual fee broke down into 11 equal payments)

Youth, Junior, Senior- \$285-\$325 per month (depending on age/level) (based on an annual fee broke down into 11 equal monthly payments)

Senior Level 5 - \$300-\$345 (based on an annual fee broke down into 11 monthly payments)

The highest number in the range is the absolute highest possible monthly cost. Step 1 Allstars anticipates the cost to be lower in the range, but we like to prepare our customers for the all possible fees)



Additional Fees

Travel Team Uniform Fee - \$350-\$425

Non-Travel Team Uniform Fee - \$200-\$300

Registration Fee - \$275.00 (Due in May and includes practice wear, May practices, and annual registration fee)

USASF Fee - \$30 (this is done on by athlete/parent not billed out through Step 1 Allstars)

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Specific Competition/Other Fees

- *UCA Allstar Fee* – if UCA is on the schedule for a team, the approximate minimum athlete fee of \$300.00 (based on '17-18 competition fee; this is not included in the all-inclusive fee as it is a package based fee and changes family to family)
- *Worlds Coaches Fee* - \$100-\$200 (For our coach travel, lodging, etc.)
- *Worlds Fee* - \$370 at minimum without travel (Teams that qualify for the Cheerleading Worlds and attend as commuters can expect to pay \$330 or more if attending on an At-Large Bid. Teams that receive PAID bids will not incur this competition expense. This DOES NOT include lodging or travel)
- *Summit Coaches Fee* - \$100-\$200 (For coach travel, lodging, etc.)

Summit Fee - \$295 at minimum without travel (Teams that qualify for The Summit and attend as commuters can be expected to pay \$285 or more if attending on an At-Large Bid. Teams that receive PAID bids will not incur this competition expense. This DOES NOT include lodging or travel)

**Although competition cheer is not as costly as some other youth activities, it can still be considered costly. Please realize that there are additional expenses that will occur by attending competitions, in addition to the gym fees and above listed fees. We have created annual fees for our programs that allow us to factor in the expenses for your athlete for the entire year, including competition entry fees that can be very costly, tumbling class, choreography, music and many other team related expenses. Step 1 Allstars will collect 11 equal all-inclusive monthly payments for the season for your convenience.

These fees may differ if you join late in the season

** In addition we also have a pay in full option upon request**

It is important to remember that many other programs may not collect fees in the same manner. It is not uncommon for a gym to advertise a low monthly fee for “tuition” and charge extra fees for the rest of their expenses, or to neglect to advertise all fees in a manner to appear less expensive. Step 1 Allstars aims to provide our customers with a program that is worth the investment (our fees include tumbling class), and upfront financial information. We anticipate that this “all inclusive” model will work great for our customers to plan their expenses easier.



Travel Expenses

Travel is not included and will not be billed out through Step 1 Allstars. It is the responsibility of the athletes/family to make and pay for all travel arrangements. Although many of our competitions are local and do not require extensive travel, higher level teams, Worlds and/or Summit teams may incur more travel than other teams. We do our best to keep travel to a minimum when possible in conjunction with providing the best experience for the athletes and their teams.
